

Brain Recovery Academy Foundation Course 1&2 Germany/Greece 2023

We are delighted to announce an extraordinary opportunity to learn the Brain Recovery Protocol.

In this 2 weekend course participants will learn the essentials necessary for the diagnosis and treatment of acquired brain injury (ABI). This non-invasive brain treatment was first observed to influence brain recovery in late 2016.

Treatments are made through a 'Paired Associative Stimulus (PAS) where peripheral, transcranial magnetic and somatosensory localization stimulation are combined into a powerful tool for brain recovery. This new 'Brain Recovery Protocol' allows the therapist to not only identify but amplify a brain recovery plasticity in a way that is rarely seen.

The envisaged option to return to Fuerteventura proved impossible due to restrictive hotel conditions and pricing. What at first seemed to be a disaster was perhaps destined to be because it has turned into what we think will be a much greater and exciting learning experience.

The first weekend held in Freising, Munich Airport area will teach the essentials necessary for Brain Recovery (BR) diagnosis and treatment of ABI and prepare the individual for the second weekend.

Weekend 2 will be held at the Evexia Rehabilitation Centre in Chalkidiki, Greece.

It is here where the first clinical trials on BR stroke recovery were made. Evexia center has graciously allowed us to hold the seminar on their premises, where participants will not only learn advanced BR protocols, but participate in the treatment of 'virtual' stroke/TBI patients.

Pre- and post-treatment gait and balance examinations will be made 'on site' so that real-time results can be seen.

Because the event is in November, no one will be thinking of sunning on the beach, so more time can be spent on learning in this very special environment.

The course outline at the end of this document is an overall guideline. Both the seminars in Germany and Greece are a single entity.

The participation in the first seminar only is possible but it is recommended to take part in both seminars as there will be a fluent transition of topics as required. The single participation in the seminar in Greece can only be allowed for practitioners experienced in the method in order to avoid skills gaps which will compromise the flux of the learning event.

1. The organizer is not liable for the correctness and applicability of the teaching content conveyed by the speaker(s).
2. If the training course has to be cancelled at short notice due to illness of speakers, under-occupancy or other reasons for which the organizers are not responsible, the course participant is only entitled to a refund of course fees already paid.
