## General terms and conditions

1. The organizer is not liable for the accuracy and applicability of the teaching content imparted by the speakers.
2. Should further training courses have to be canceled at short notice due to the illness of speakers or for other reasons beyond the control of the organizers, course participants shall only be entitled to a refund of course fees already paid. Further claims are excluded even if the course participant has already incurred further costs, e.g. due to canceling patients, booking accommodation, travel or similar. The course participant is liable for the payment of the course fee for the course, regardless of any third-party benefits that may have been applied for (e.g. employment office, education voucher). Cancellations due to under-subscription will be made no later than 3 weeks before the start of the course.
3. For cancellations up to 2 weeks before the start of the seminar, a processing fee of €50 will be charged. For later cancellations, the seminar fees will be forfeited.
4. Tuition fees will not be reimbursed for lessons that course participants are unable to attend due to illness or other reasons. This will be noted on the certificate of attendance.
